We have been able to incorporate much of it in our land use plan objectives, and manifested it in land use designations and associated implementation measures. .



Community Feedback & Response:

- **More waterfront recreation**
 - New land use designation in Cow Bay
 - Kitson Island designated as recreation area
 - Commitment to identify new projects & trails
- **More environmental protection & compensation**
 - Flora Bank moratorium
 - New land use designations for marine habitat and viewscape and shoreline buffers
 - Commitment to proactively model and monitor cumulative effects of operations
- **More public engagement**
 - Increased frequency of land use plan updates
 - Establishment of multi-party regional planning and referral processes
 - Investigate new approaches to manage local social/cultural/historical impacts from port development
