NOTICE TO ALL CUSTOMERS

RE: 2023 TARIFF

The Prince Rupert Port Authority hereby provides notice of a proposed tariff revision that would come into effect on January 1, 2023.

The proposed revisions are set out below:

1. Increase:

Harbour Dues – Increase harbour dues by 5.86%.

Anchorage Fees – No change, schedule to remain \$0.00.

Wharfage Fees – 11.15% increase applied to all container wharfage fees and an increase of 5.86% for all cargoes otherwise specified.

Lighterage Fees – 5.86% increase applied to project cargo, logs and all cargoes not otherwise specified.

Berthage Fees – Increase berthage fees by 5.86% for both working and non-working periods.

Dockage Fees – Increase dockage fees by 5.86%.

Services and Facilities Fees – Increase Northland port call and security fees by 5.86%. **Water Service Fees** – Increase water service fees by 5.86%.

2. Tariff Schedule and Structural Change:

- a) Removal of Schedule 9 Fairview Connector Road Fee

 (i) Removal of this Schedule is being done acknowledging industry feedback including a
 preference for this cost to be incorporated into container wharfage
- b) Removal of Schedule 10 Ridley Island Project Cargo Fees

(i) Removal of this Schedule is being done as there is no longer any possibility of loading project cargo to and from rail on Ridley Island

c) Removal of Slack Wax Item 3200 in Schedule 3 — Wharfage Fees

 (i) Removal of this Item is being done now that the slack wax tanks and related operation has been removed to make way for the expansion of Fairview container terminal
