

ANNUAL REPORT TO PARLIAMENT

ACCESS TO INFORMATION ACT

REPORTING PERIOD: APRIL 1, 2024, TO MARCH 31, 2025

Introduction

The Access to Information Act (the "Act") provides Canadian citizens, permanent residents, or any person or corporation present in Canada a right to access information, within the provisions of the Act, that is contained in government records.

Prince Rupert Port Authority ("PRPA") is listed in Schedule 1 of the Act, and pursuant to section 94, has prepared this annual report on the application of the Act within the organization to be tabled in Parliament by the Minister of Transportation, the Minister responsible for Canada Port Authorities. PRPA had no non-operational subsidiaries during the reporting period applicable to this report.

PRPA is a Canada Port Authority ("CPA") established by virtue of Letters Patent, issued by the Minister of Transportation pursuant to Section 8 of the *Canada Marine Act.* As a PRPA is responsible for administering activities within the Port of Prince Rupert related to shipping, navigation, transportation of passengers and goods, and the handling and storage of goods, with a mission to develop and grow the Port of Prince Rupert in a sustainable, economical, safe and environmentally sound manner.

This report is intended to fulfill the reporting requirements of only the PRPA. The PRPA does not have any non-operations subsidiaries during this reporting period.

Access to Information Program

The President and Chief Executive Officer of the Prince Rupert Port Authority is the Head of the Institution for the purpose of administering the Act. The responsibilities of the Head of the Institution under the Act have been delegated to the Vice President, Commercial and Regulatory Affairs (the "Delegated Head"), pursuant to the attached Delegation of Authority Order of April 20, 2023. The Director, Regulatory Compliance is acting temporarily as PRPA's Access to Information and Privacy Coordinator ("ATIP Coordinator").

Procedures and Monitoring

Procedures are in place directing all formal *Access to Information Act* Requests ("Requests") and enquiries to the ATIP Coordinator, under the supervision of the Delegated Head, who ensures that Requests are processed in accordance with the Act.

The ATIP Coordinator monitors the processing time of the Requests and reports monthly to the Delegated Head of the program. The ATIP Coordinator ensures that responses to Requests are in compliance with the Act, and endeavors to respond to Requests within the prescribed 30-day timeline.

PRPA was not party to any service agreements under section 96 of the Act.

As required by the Directive on Access to Information, summaries of completed Access to Information (ATI) requests are published on the Open Government portal.

Performance 2024-2025

PRPA received one (1) formal Access to Information Requests (the "Requests") during the period of April 1, 2024, to March 31, 2025 (the "Current Reporting Period"). The response to the Request required two extensions due to the volume of material to be reviewed and to allow for consultation with external third parties. The extensions were applied in conformance with the Act and the Request was fulfilled within the legislated timeframes.

A summary of PRPA's activities for April 1, 2024 to March 31, 2025 (the "Current Reporting Period) is shown below.

Formal Access to Information Requests ("Requests")

- One formal Request was received;
- PRPA required two extensions to complete the response due to the volume of material to be reviewed and to allow for external third-party consultation
- The Request response was fulfilled in eighty (80) days, within the legislated timelines allowing for extensions, representing a one hundred percent (100 %) response rate within legislated timelines.

Requests Carried Over

- There are no Requests carried over from the Current Reporting Period
- PRPA had seven (7) Requests carried forward from previous reporting periods, as described below
 - Two (2) Requests were carried forward from the 2023-24 reporting period were the subject of complaints to the Office of the Information Commissioner (the "OIC"); however, both Requests were closed in June 2025, which will be reflected in next year's report; of note, both Requests are the subject of continued investigation by the OIC
 - Two (2) Requests are carried forward from the 2022-23 reporting period; preparation of the annual report for the current reporting period revealed that one (1) Request has been incorrectly recorded and carried forward. This administrative error will be corrected in the subsequent reporting period. Also, one (1) Request was partially responded to but given the information requested is the subject of active litigation the parties have agreed to deal with the request through the document disclosure process of the litigation.
 - Three (3) Requests have been carried forward from the 2018-2019 reporting period; two (2) Requests were responded to in part; the Requests predate staff currently managing Requests and information concerning actions taken to respond is limited; PRPA acknowledges the time the Requests have been on file and is working to respond and close the Requests within the 2025-2026 reporting period

For the Current Reporting Period, no Consultations ("Consultation Requests") were received from other Government of Canada Institutions.

The attached Statistical Report provides a more detailed summary of data on Requests received between April 1, 2024, and March 31, 2025.

Training and Awareness

During the Current Reporting Period informal briefings and updates were provided by the ATIP Coordinator at meetings held by various departments. Information was provided on PRPA's obligations for proactive disclosure to applicable departments.

PRPA has been actively participating in virtual training sessions put on by the Access to Information and Privacy Communities Development Office (APCDO).

PRPA has in the past successfully secured training through the Canada School of Public Service ("CSPS"). PRPA has since been advised that the organization is no longer eligible to use the services of CSPS. PRPA is seeking alternative means of acquiring training.

PRPA is actively recruiting for a new position that will take over responding to Requests and develop a program for training and promoting awareness of the organization's responsibilities within the Act.

Policies, Guidelines and Procedures

No new policies, guidelines or procedures related to the Act were implemented by PRPA during the Current Reporting Period.

Proactive Publication

PRPA is a government institution as defined within the Act and therefore is subject to the reporting requirements of Part 2 – Proactive Publication of Information as shown below.
